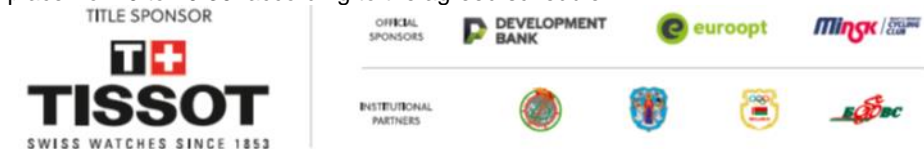

Please respect these designations. Please do not argue with the stewards and security personnel who have been instructed to maintain access control as designated by the event management. Any abuse towards stewards / security will not be tolerated and all incidents will be reported immediately to the UCI.

Entry on the MINSK ARENA VELODROME in Minsk from Thursday 29th October is possibly only with accreditation. The training is closed for the fans. Accreditations are ready to be picked up near main entrance in Accreditation Center. The training takes place from 9 to 19:30 according to the agreed schedule.

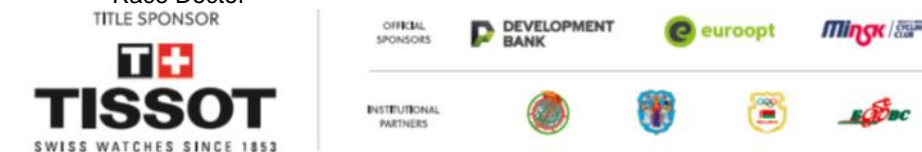

TEAM PARKING AND TEAM ROOMS

Teams will be met by Transport Coordinator Leanid Smolski at the main Vehicle Entrance and will be directed to their allocated Team Storage. Rooms are allocated on the ground floor of the Velodrome and are provided with lighting.

The team rooms are covered by security 24 hours a day from Monday morning 28th October until Sunday 3rd November.

Due to the numbers of teams entered and space limitations it will be necessary for some smaller teams to share cabins.

Teams can use parking space near Velodrome. They can access the building through the main and side entrances.

TRACK CENTRE TEAM PENS

Team pens were allocated in the track in-field taking into account the size of each team. Space is limited so please keep to your allocated area.

Please, ensure that equipment doesn't block or narrow walkways so that the track could be cleared quickly in case of emergency.

ACCES TO SEATING FOR TEAM PERSONNEL

Rider accreditations will allow access to the concourse. All athletes and team officials must wear the accreditation to access.

DOPING CONTROL

Anti-doping drug test will be carried out by the UCI Doping Control Officers (Nevena Avalic, Lovro Ziberna, Jaroslaw Gargol) appointed and in accordance with the UCI regulations. The anti-doping rooms are located on the 1st floor.

RIDER SAFETY

Riders must wear a helmet at all the time whilst on the track. The use of personal stereo equipment whilst riding on the track is forbidden.

Whilst out on the roads remember to not drive on the right way. After dark you will require a front and back light fitted to your bike. Red traffic signal lights mean „stop“. Ensure you adhere to all road signs and do not ride on the footway this is illegal and may result in a fine. Please make sure you have your ID with you when you are outside the venue.

TEAM CHANGING ROOM

There is a male and female changing room and shower facilities available in Minsk.

TEAM MEDICAL

A team of doctors and paramedics will be present throughout official training and competition. The team will be based in the track centre during training and racing.

Outside official training and competition time, emergency medical care is available through the national public health service for medical care. They are contacted in an emergency by dialing 103, please inform our facility manager Uladzimir MURAVSKI (phone +375 29 6772616) if you call for an ambulance.

TEAM OFFICIAL TRAINING SCHEDULE

The track will be available for official training on Tuesday 29 October, Wednesday 30 October and Thursday 31 October. The schedule for training is available on the UCI website, in the accreditation center and in this event manual.

Reminder of safety instructions for official trainings session

- Teams must respect the slots defined by the UCI.
- All riders must wear the national team apparel.



- Road bikes are not allowed on the track, neither on the security zone.
- The use of thermal motor or electrical gears (deryn, motorcycle...) are prohibited.
- No coaches are allowed on the safety zone, on the back straight.
- One coach per team is allowed on the home straight. Coaches must coordinate with each other for a better secure and efficient use of the track.
- Standing starts (individual or team) are permitted only under the following conditions:
 - o on the home straight only, and
 - o with the assistance of someone waving a flag at the exit of the 4th bend to warn the other riders present on the track
 - o The use of starting gate is prohibited.

The pre-competition official training session (on competition days):

- On competition day, the track is open for official training sessions 2 hours before the start of the competitions. Except on Sunday, where the track opens 1 hour before the start of the competitions.
- In between sessions, when possible, the track is open for 1 hour for riders competing in the next session only.
- The pre-competition official training session ends 10 minutes before the start of the competition.





• On competition day, standing starts are allowed one rider at a time and on the home straight in the sprinter's lane only (all other conditions remain).

The Technical Delegate - appointed by the UCI or by the organizer - has the power to take the necessary measures to ensure security on the one hand and equity among the other teams on the other.

CEREMONY

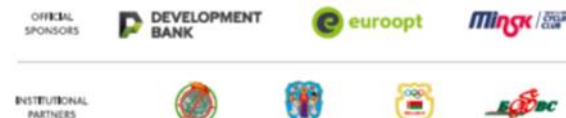
INFORMATION FOR EVENT PERSONEL
